MPhil degree in a relevant discipline of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS) (with first division as defined by the awarding Institute/ University) AND UGC-JRF in the relevant discipline of HSS/Humanities

OR

Master's degree in a relevant specialization of HSS (with first division as defined by the awarding Institute/ University) AND UGC-JRF in Humanities/HSS.

OR

Masters' degree in other relevant specialization of these two research areas (with first division as defined by the awarding Institute/ University) AND UGC-JRF/Equivalent Fellowship.

GATE qualification is not compulsory for DF / IS / CT / SW category.
